

Directions to Hangman Hills

From I-90 East or South Hill: Head south to 29th and Regal. Drive south on Regal to 57th Avenue and turn left (east). Go 0.8 miles to first light and then turn right onto the Old Palouse Highway. Follow the Old Palouse Highway 2.5 miles down a hill and then up a steep curving hill to Baltimore Road, which is just past the crest of the hill. Turn right (southerly) onto Baltimore Road and proceed 1.8 miles down a long hill and you will see the Hangman Hills housing area on the right. Turn right at the Hangman Hills entrance sign (Trevino). If you miss the first Hangman Hills entrance, there is a second one a half mile further down the hill at Casper. Each entrance drive dead-ends at Player Drive; Casper is one very long block, while Trevino is a very short block. Player is the “main drag” in Hangman Hills; it is a long, horseshoe-shaped road.

From West Spokane: Take the Pullman Highway (SR195) 4.8 miles south to Hatch Road. Turn left (east) on Hatch (it is a “T” intersection with freeway-style lighting) and cross the bridge, proceeding a quarter mile to Hangman Valley Road, which tees in from the right. Make a right turn (south) onto Hangman Valley Road and proceed 4.5 miles to Casper Drive. You will see the Latah Valley golf course off to your right. Turn left at the Hangman Hills sign (Casper). If you miss the first entrance, there is a second one a half mile further up the hill, at Trevino. Each entrance drive dead-ends at Player Drive; Trevino is a very short block, while Casper is one very long block. Player is the “main drag” in Hangman Hills; it is a long, horseshoe-shaped road.
